The only support I got was from my one friend who lived near me. One morning, I arrived at school, and there was a vase of flowers on my desk. My classmates were all standing around, laughing at me. In Japan, a vase with white flowers is used to mourn the dead. The worst part was I found out that the culprit was my one and only friend. At that moment, I thought it might be better for me to die. Caught between shame and anger, I suffered alone in torment for many years.

One day, I happened to meet a foreigner who invited me to church. I learned about Jesus' love and how he forgives us for all the wrongs we've done. From there, I realized I was still holding on to my past.

After I accepted God into my life, I spotted my old primary school friend on the train. I wasn't sure whether to talk to him or not. But then I thought to myself, "How would Jesus react to this situation?" So, I was able to go and talk to him. We chatted for a while, then he suddenly broke down in tears. And he said, "I'm so sorry for what I did to you back then." I was quite surprised. I felt very happy that he apologized. I told him don't worry and that I'd long forgiven him, and instead, that I loved him. I felt a huge weight lifted.

By letting go of anger and the desire for revenge, I was free to be happy, to trust people and to live meaningfully. The gift of Jesus is love and forgiveness. By passing on this gift to others, I've learned we can experience true freedom for ourselves.
