The Good News – Our Most Important Message

The good news is for messed up, rebellious, broken people. The more broken and messed up you are, the more the good news is for you!

The good news is that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. He became sin in order that we would become righteous, and our acceptance from God is not based on our goodness, but on Jesus' goodness.

Because of that, God's love and acceptance for us is "never stopping, never giving up, un-breaking, always and forever love." - Sally Lloyd-Jones

The one requirement necessary for this good news to be true of you and me is that we receive it by faith and surrender our lives and our will to His.

Unfortunately, we don't have what it takes to produce the faith that is necessary to believe.

But God, because He is rich in mercy and abounding in steadfast love, by His grace, His Son, and His Spirit, He produces in us the faith that is necessary to believe,

and that's what we call the Good News!

My Calling

- WOOD FLOOR STORY "The people you're encountering is not by accident. I'm sending them to you, because I've called you to be 'a shepherd to lost and hurting people.'"
- I'm the pastor but I'm no better than you, not as smart as you, I'm as much or more broken than you, and I struggle with faith every day, but I'm here because God has called me into this.
- I'm so aware of my weakness, brokenness, and sinfulness, that I am desperate every day for his voice, strength, encouragement, and guidance
- I know that I do not have what it takes for this position, but I am confident that God has given me what it takes through Christ (2 Cor. 3:5 "adequacy").
- I lean on and rest in Him, but it is a struggle.
- Brokenness and weakness is not our greatest liability in our Christian faith. It's our greatest asset. "When we are weak, He is strong. His power is made perfect in our weakness." (from 2 Corinthians 12:9-11)
